# Beach Safety Update by Mike Kelly, CCL VP

#### **Croatan Beach Restoration Project**

Emerald Forest completed the dune grass sprigging on 3/28/2019. The city



engineers are currently working with Emerald Forest to secure a price to install sand fencing along the dune system. The sand fence installation effort should occur by mid-April 2019.

The schedule for the USACE to advertise the Rudee Inlet and Outer Deposition Basin Dredging project remains mid-April. Once bids are received, the schedule is still for sand placement efforts on Croatan Beach to occur between July and August.

Lynnhaven River Now (<a href="http://www.lrnow.org">http://www.lrnow.org</a> ) sponsors the **Pearl Home** initiative that encourages residents of the Chesapeake Bay watershed to exercise in-home projects that help preserve and renew the health of our waterways. **Pearl Homes** receive a yard flag or magnet proclaiming their dedication to our environment. To attain this designation, residents need only practice/perform fifteen (15) of approximately 100 actions – many of which we already do as part of our daily lives (e.g., turn off water in sink while brushing teeth, reuse shipping materials when sending packages, run only full loads of laundry). The **Pearl Home** initiative is ideal for enabling children to become stewards of their environment and educating ourselves in additional ways we can preserve our unique water-based environment for them.

# Security and Civic Involvement by M. C. Agresti

"Relax to 25." Spring, speed, strangers, safety, and smaller citizens (best I could do with alliteration). Our neighborhood saw an uptick in traffic stops during March, despite Master Police Office Don Noha (our security patrol when off-duty) being upgraded to a marked police vehicle from his unmarked "Crown Vic." Our entire neighborhood is a 25 MPH zone (conditions

permitting) but four violators paid the price. Other traffic stops included violations of Stop signs at side streets leading to Croatan Road and one stop was for two improperly secured infants riding on someone's lap. Let's "Relax to 25," chill at the beach, drive cautiously as children start to play outside (read: in the streets), and respect school buses and traffic signs.

Office Noha asked me to address new spring growth of foliage that may be obstructing traffic signs or driver sight distance. If you have a road sign, including "No Parking" or street name signs, on or adjacent to your property, or live on a corner, please take a critical look and prune back any trees or bushes that may hazard drivers.

"Something in the Water." The Pharrell Williams-sponsored festival coincides with College Beach Weekend – <u>April 27, 27, and 28</u>. His own organization's security is working closely with Virginia Beach police, fire/rescue, EMS, and other City services to make this a safe event. Crowds are expected to exceed 35,000. Parking, road closures, access to neighborhoods for residents/guests, etc. will be discussed at a special meeting to be held Monday, April 8 at the Convention Center at 6:30 PM and probably, again, at the April 10 Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC), which I attend. Due to timing, expect essential, time-critical information to be promulgated via the Nextdoor app. If you don't have Nextdoor, I recommend getting it.

**"Dogs on the Beach."** The city has posted a survey online at http://vbgov.com seeking public input on whether to adopt changes to City Code to restrict unleashed dogs from the beach 24/7. This poll is available until **April 9**. The data will be used to influence an April 10 public hearing to be held at 6:30 PM at the Law Enforcement Training Academy (411 Integrity Way - near 19<sup>th</sup> and S. Birdneck). Although the City Council appears to have placed any change on hold – at least until next year, attendance is important if you are passionate about this issue.
