Beach Safety Update from Mike Kelly, CCL VP

Croatan Beach Restoration Project

Slight delay, still on-track.



As you can see from the picture above, on November 8th, VB Public Works Operations continues to "mine" Rudee Inlet for sand and is moving it south for restoration of the Croatan Beach dune structure. It is amazing how much sand they have taken and put on the dunes. This effort has been on-going for the last three weeks and they are still working from the same spot. The Moffat & Nichol Study published in April 2017 stated that approximately 243,000 cubic yards of sand is transported along the Croatan Beach annually. Seeing this effort gives one an appreciation for how

much sand that is.

On November 1st, I received the following update from Public Works:

- The final plans are routing for final signature. At the same time, our Contracts office will be providing bid advertising dates.
- We're looking to advertise November 11th. Bids will be open in early December.
- The contract award period will take about two months. New contract review policies are in place that
 require a longer contract award period. We will work to accelerate the process as reasonably as possible.
- Contract will be awarded by mid/late January 2019.
- The sand truck haul work to get underway by the second week of February 2019.
- The sand truck haul work will take between 2 and 3 months (weather depending).
- We will plan on conducting a community update meeting in mid-January 2019.

As I said, the larger restoration effort is slightly delayed, but that may not be bad as it will come towards the end of our Winter bad weather period.



There were four crimes reported for the month of October.

- 10/6 Atlantic Ave. Breaking and Entering
- 10/6 Atlantic Ave. Destruction of Private Property
- 10/9 Atlantic Ave. Breaking and Entering
- 10/26 Croatan Hills Dr. Destruction of Private Property



The break-ins on S. Atlantic Ave. were two young men who were part of the Virginia National Guard Commonwealth Challenge Youth Academy located on Camp Pendleton. http://www.vachallenge.org/. The perpetrators were apprehended. Officer Noha reports that this is very unusual. He does not remember an incident like this in the twenty years that he has conducted neighborhood patrols for us.

The crime on Croatan Hills Dr. was childish and cowardly. Someone pulled up a political sign for a Democrat candidate and then used it to damage the car in the driveway. This behavior is wrong in so many ways.

Officer Noha patrolled the neighborhood for 25 hours – 9.0 hours on speed control, 16.0 hours on neighborhood patrol. He handed out 6parking tickets.

Help with "Scoop the Poop" by Marian Kitchin

The Croatan Civic League needs your help. Many of our poop bag dispensers are empty. The best thing to fill them with is the plastic sleeve the newspaper comes in. If you have any of these plastic sleeves available, please place them in one of our dispensers. The dispensers are at the following locations:

- Lockheed Avenue beach access
- Maryland Avenue beach access
- Aqua Lane beach access
- Croatan Road beach access
- Twilight Lane beach access
- The Point beach access
- Fort Raleigh Drive entrance to the Secret Bridge
- The bridge between Secotan Road and Christine Lane

Dog owners and walkers, please pick up the poop and either dispose it at home or at one of the trash receptacles on the beach. Do not place it in the dispenser or beside it.

The city code states the following:

Virginia Beach

City of

Sec. 5-534. - Allowing dogs or horses to urinate or defecate on public or private property.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or person in immediate control of a dog or horse to:

(1) Allow his/her dog or horse to urinate or defecate on the private property of other persons without their consent or that of the authorized agent of the one having control of the premises. (2) Allow his/her dog or horse to defecate on public property, except that defecation by a dog or horse on public property shall not constitute a violation of this section if the owner or person in immediate control of the dog or horse immediately removes the material defected and disposes of it in a safe and sanitary manner.

SCOOP THE POOP!!!!! It's the LAW!!! Please carry a plastic bag with you when you walk your dog. Don't let pet waste become part of our waterways or our neighbor's landscape.
