# Croatan Civic League — September Board Meeting Minutes

#### **Meeting and Attendance Confirmation**

Mike Kelly called the meeting to order and confirmed quorum. The meeting began at **6:34 PM on Monday, July 7th**.

#### 1. Treasurer's Report — Pat Costigan

- Accounts stable; no emerging issues.
- Current balance: **\$42,630**.
- Estimated spend remainder of year: \$7,500-8,000.
  - Primarily for Annual Meeting and December Social

#### 2. Membership — Bob Lougen / Jim Ferrera

- 46 new members from 2024 end-of-year campaign; dues ≈ \$3,035.
- Member households: ≈ 264–265 (≈ 51% of properties; ≈ 472 people).
- Risk: Jim Ferrera believes that without continued canvassing, up to 50% of the 46 could lapse.
- Annual Dinner (Oct 26, Warriors Tap House): Invite new neighbors as a recruitment event. CCL to cover meals for invited new members (confirm policy).

#### 3. Website Update — Bob Lougen

- Add website note that any new members joining from 1 October to 31 December will have their dues covered for 2026.
- Enable RSVP for Oct 26 Annual Dinner.

#### 4. Security / CAC — Connie Agresti

School zones: Officers issuing citations for traffic and parking violations.

- No lifeguards currently at Croatan; hurricane season ongoing.
- **E-bikes:** complaints rising. Task group reviewing regulations (beach ban, lights at night, helmet rules, speedometer requirement possible). Safety concerns with youth speeding.
- **Dogs on beach:** Reminder of leash rules and cleanup.
- Fire hydrants: 20 identified in Croatan (1 out of service). Most rated **1500+ GPM**; one at 1000–1499 GPM. Concern about hydrant spacing (<800ft). Connie to engage Fire Chief. (Update: CVB map shows 24 in Croatan and two on Gen Booth Blvd.)
- Parking lot: Free after Oct 1; closes at 5:30 PM.
- **Street closures:** Board requested earlier City communication. CAC meets at Rescue Squad #14.

#### 5. VBCCO — Jim Ferrera

- **District voting:** Discussed 10-1 vs 7-3-1 models.
  - Will there any debate or other information seminar prior to voting?
- Insurance: Directors & Officers insurance policy acquired.
- Other topics: e-bike safety, golf cart parking enforcement.
- Next VBCCO: Sep 17, Bow Creek Rec Center. Jim away; no alternate secured.

- Delivered baskets to new neighbors. Positive feedback letters received.
- Highlighted strong new interest in community involvement.

- New contractor (First Colonial) praised.
- Entrance plan: red, white, and blue pansies for 250th Years of U.S.
- Hazard: low pine branches on Croatan Rd hitting delivery trucks.
- Lumos fiber project ongoing; easement impacts likely. Advise residents to photo-document property. (Note: Needs more follow-up. This will be a big issue.)
